Award(s) will be made as funds are available, and people who apply must meet the following criteria:

- Must be a Pennsylvania resident (list name, address, and phone number)
- Must have Cystic Fibrosis (submit doctor's note, on his/her letterhead stationary, indicating you have CF, and have doctor sign it.)
- Indicate what college, university, trade school, or institution of higher learning you are planning to attend.
- Statement of need (what funds you have already obtained from parents, scholarships, grants, loans, etc., and what funds are still needed.)
- Submit high school or college transcripts and indicate your possible major.
- Write a 300-500 word essay telling us about yourself, your ambitions, and your educational goals. Describe how these funds will help you to achieve your educational goals.
